Employee “Wage” Insurance:

You have an insurance policy that pays your wages if you can not work!

1. If you break your leg on the steps at home and can “not” work for an extended period of time, how would your bills get paid? Could you afford to miss the work?
2. If you suffered a heart-attach and can not perform your job duties during the recovery time, could you afford the loss of pay?
3. If you have a minor in and out surgery and end up with a staff infection that requires you to be off work unexpectedly for up to 120 days! Could you afford a loss like that?

The City of Salem and Local 2067 have bargained such a wage insurance plan!
It is known by it’s academic term “SICK PLAN”.

The sick plan was designed to be an insurance plan to protect you against loss of wages and guarantee job security (within reason) when you are sick or unable to work.

Some people however, are spending this insurance money before they really need it. But by doing this, they will not have the protection they need should they break a leg, or suffer any other unexpected illness that could keep them from working for more than a week.

Every employee should strive to maintain at least 200 hours of “sick plan” time on the books and that is only enough coverage for five (5) weeks of pay. If you need to be off more than that, you had better have some vacation or other time accrued. Because the city
